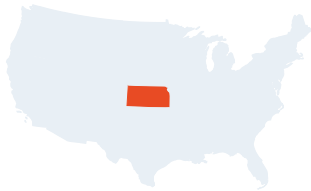


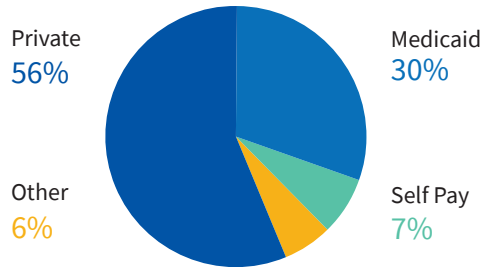

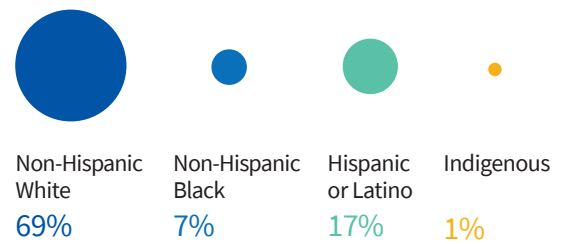

Births by race-ethnicity¹



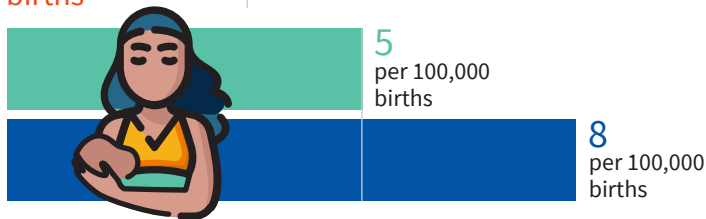

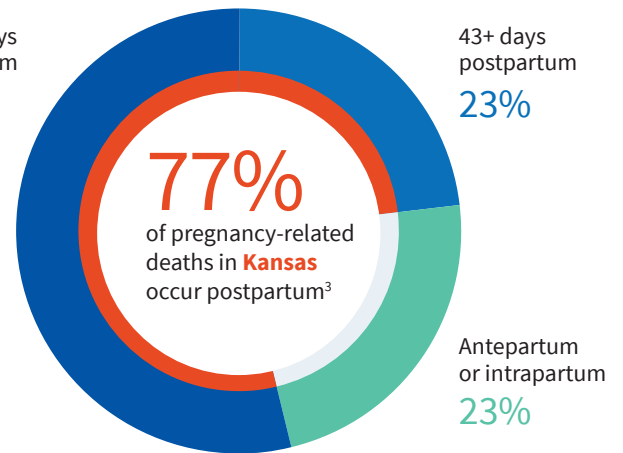
Racial-ethnic minorities people in Kansas are **1.6x more likely** to die from pregnancy-related causes compared to white people³

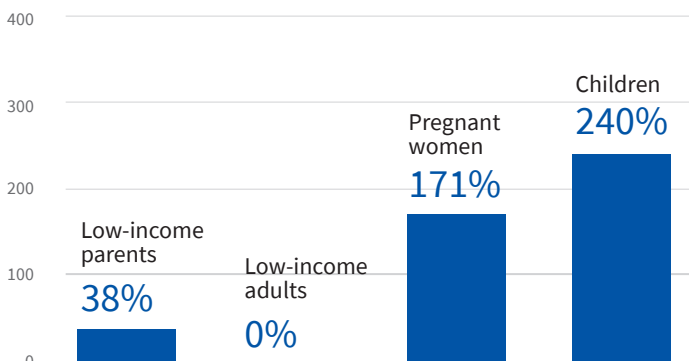
