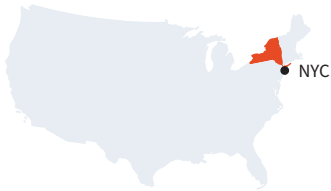


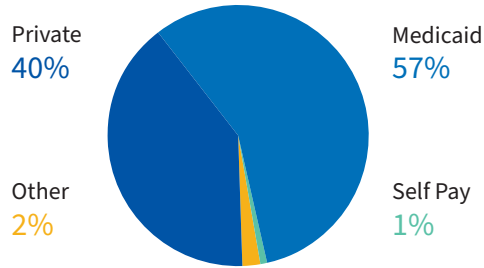

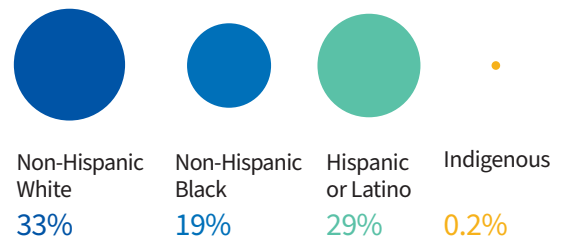

Black people in NYC are **3.6x more likely** to die from pregnancy-related causes compared to Hispanic people and **7.7x more likely** compared to white people³

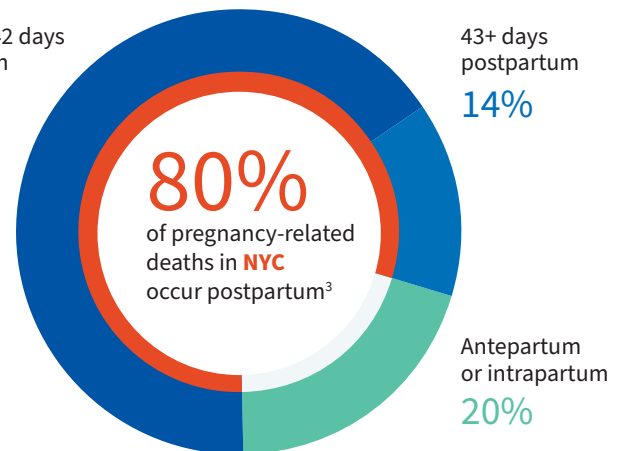

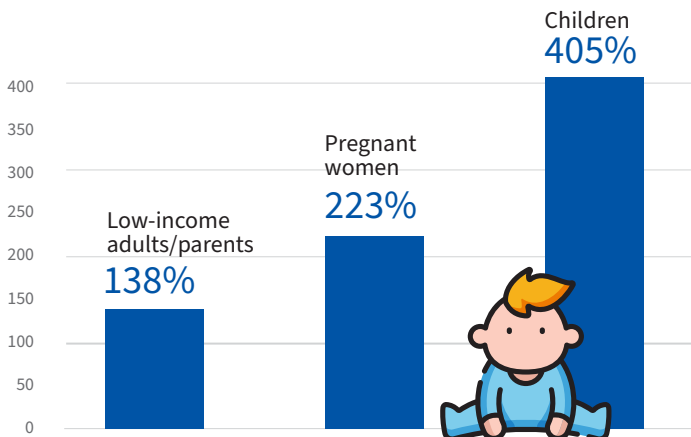
