Mi madre 76 años con algo de artrosis y la tensión un poco alta, xo no preocupante. Después de la 1 con moderna empezó a tener problemas con un ojo, molestias, aunq no nos dijo nada hasta más tarde. Tras la 2 dosis el problema en el ojo se agravó, tenía el párpado hinchado, el ojo le lloraba, veía borroso y ha perdido algo de visión en el ojo y ella operada de cataratas veía mejor q yo. No dieron con la causa, el caso es q no tiene solución. A la semana empezó a tener parestesias en mano y brazo izquierdos q no eran el lado de la inyección. Las parestesias realmente le cogían toda la zona izquierda del cuerpo, al final fue llevada a urgencias porque podía ser un ictus, allí le hicieron PCR, salió negativo, la tensión la tenía x las nubes y tras pruebas vieron una isquemia lacunar en el cerebro. Después de más d 1 semana ingresada mejoró, xo tiene q tomar pastillas xa la tensión y todavía sigue con algo de sensación de acorchamiento en esa zona. **Mi padre con 83, sin patologías**, tras vacunarse con pfizer lo veo más cansado, se cansa mucho antes y tiene un eccema en la piel, xo no sé si será x la vacuna. **Un amigo tras 2 dosis de pfizer tuvo uveitis** y estuvo 1 semana tratándose el ojo. Ahora está bien. La madre de una amiga, tras pfizer sufrió una encefalitis. La hermana de un amigo, tras la primera de pfizer sufrió problemas hormonales ya q el periodo se le desreguló. **Hay otros dos casos q acabaron en muerte, xo me tendría q asegurar de la posible relación con las vacunas**

## ENGLISH

My 76-year-old mother has some osteoarthritis and a little high blood pressure, but not concerned. After the first Moderna vaccine **began to have problems with one eye, discomfort, though she did not tell us anything until later**. After the second dose **the problem in the eye worsened**, her eyelid was swollen and tearing. She had blurry vision and lost vision in the eye (where after her cataract surgery, she used to see better than me). No [official] cause or solution was found in her case. A week later **she began to have paresthesias [burning] in the left hand and arm**, on the other side of the injection. The paresthesias really took the entire left area of the body. In the end she was taken to the emergency room because it could be a stroke. There they did a PCR test, it was negative [...] After more than one week of hospitalization, she improved. She now has to take pills because of the tension and she still has some feeling of corking in that area. **My father is 83 years old, without pathologies**. After being vaccinated with Pfizer he is more tired and has eczema on the skin [...] **A friend after 2 doses of pfizer got uveitis** [eye inflammation] and spent one week treating it. It's OK now. The mother of a friend, after Pfizer, suffered encephalitis. The sister of a friend, after the first one from Pfizer, suffered hormonal problems since her period was deregulated. **There are two other cases that ended in death, but I would have to make sure of the possible relationship with the vaccines.**

**a.** Begins with a familial, community relationship (“uncle,” “grandma,” “friend of a friend”), age, location and specific vaccine type.

**b.** Establishes veracity in local detail but also resembles professional medical patient history.

**c.** Lists a number of idiopathic, non-specific symptoms that are difficult to diagnose (“swelling,” “redness,” “unexplained headaches,” “changes in menstruation” etc.)

**d.** Seeks validation and documentation in aggregate of stories, where in the mind of the participants a pattern emerges, and a pattern that is being ignored by the medical establishment.

**e.** Ends with a discussion about causation, surprisingly open ended (“perhaps related, but my uncle doesn’t think so.”) Mind not made up.
